List of Top Priorities - 2007

On March 1, 2007, during the monthly CCCA community meeting, the list of Top Priorities and Recommendations was updated for 2007 by an open vote. All issues were listed on the board and each person in attendance was given one Priority1, P2 and P3 stickers and asked to vote for their top 3 issues. The following are the results of this vote which set the CCCA's priorities for 2007. For further information, please visit our website at cardinalcreek.org or contact us at info@cardinalcreek.org.

Recreational Facilities/Parks/Bicycle Paths – Top Priority (Gold) for 2007 (7 x P1, 3 x P2, 1 x P3 = 28 votes)

- **Completion of interim work on Park 18-B** – no work performed since early October 2006; Priority to complete grading, resurfacing and begin maintenance (*received 3 x P1 and 1 x P2 votes*);
- **Completion of Valin Park** – no work performed since November 2006; Rideau Valley Conservation Authority problem with storm water pond to be addressed and park completed. Park structures need to be tendered and announced (*received 2 x P1, 2 x P2, 1 x P3 votes*);
- **Fund raiser to sod part of Park 18-B** – suggested as a way to advance park development;
- **Community input on Pine Vista park** – no further information has been received on this pocket park;
- **Additional Summer programs needed for Cassia Park** – residents would like to see a basketball court and other summer activities added to Cassia Park (*received 2 x P1 votes*).

OC Transpo – Priority 2 (Silver) for 2007 (5 x P1, 2 x P2, 1 x P3 = 20 votes)

- **Increase frequency of 22 Express service** (*received 1 x P2 votes*);
- **Increase local 136 frequency** during peak hours (*received 1 x P1 votes and 1 x P2 votes*);
- **Review 136 route** and time mark locations;
- **Extend 136 into Springridge and East Village** especially off peak hours (*received 2 x P1 and 1 x P3 votes*);
- **Extend 94 along Valin and down Trim** to connect with Trim Park & Ride (*received 1 x P1 votes*);
- **Extend 101/102 to Trim Road Park and Ride** – Orleans to Kanata (*received 1 x P1 votes*);
- **OC Transpo to attend CCCA Meeting** to discuss future service improvements – April 5.

Traffic – Priority 3 (Bronze) for 2007 (1 x P1, 4 x P2, 4 x P3 = 15 votes)

- **Timing of traffic lights** (long wait) at Trim/Valin (*received 1 x P2 and 1 x P3 votes*);
- **Painting of lines and directional arrows** at Trim/Valin and Trim/Springridge (*received 2 x P2 votes and 3 x P3 votes*);
- **Traffic lights at Portobello/Valin intersection** (*received 1 x P1 votes*);
- **Stop vehicular traffic using Kings Pointe walking path** (*received 1 x P2 votes*).

Environmental – Priority 4 for 2007 (5 x P2, 1 x P3 = 11 votes)

- **Need for rehabilitation of public properties**; (*received 1 x P2 votes*)
- **Require builders to remove black cloth fencing along ravines**;
- **Planting of more trees through various grant programs**; (*received 1 x P2 votes*)
- **Implement sustainable environmental programs** (e.g. green box); (*received 1 x P2 votes*)
- **Support various environment initiatives via other not-for-profit groups** (e.g. Composting, Dream Green, World Earth Day, Hydro One Thermostats, Bull Frog Power, Project Porchlight – energy efficient light bulbs); (*received 2 x P2 and 1 x P3 votes*).
- **Promote environmental initiatives in Cardinal Creek Tribune Newsletter.**

Neighbourhood Watch – Priority 5 for 2007 (1 x P1, 1 x P2, 3 x P3 = 8 votes)

- **Graffiti enforcement** – extend graffiti program to east of Trim Rd (*received 1 x P2 votes and 1 x P3 votes*);
- **Develop neighbourhood watch**; (*received 1 x P1 votes and 2 x P3 votes*).

Home Builder Issues – Priority 6 for 2007 (4 x P3 = 4 votes)

- **Enforcement of street and area cleaning responsibilities** (*received 2 x P3 votes*);
- **Removal of garbage bins and keep sidewalks clear** (*received 1 x P3 votes*);
- **Removal of cement barriers and/or paint green**;
- **Address overcrowding in schools – Maple Ridge** (*received 1 x P3 votes*).
