We're making adjustments to bus routes to better support the travel needs of customers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Service improvements

Service will be improved on a number of routes to better support current travel needs, with an emphasis on hospitals, shopping districts, and growing employment areas.



New Route 110 Innovation / Fallowfield

A new local route will be added to replace Route 179. Route 110 will increase connectivity between Barrhaven and Kanata and will improve connections to the CitiGate area, including the new Amazon building. Buses will run between Fallowfield Station and Innovation Station every 30 minutes during weekdays.

Route suspensions

Some peak-period routes will be suspended due to low ridership. Alternative routes are available nearby.



Route adjustments

Some routes will be adjusted where parallel service is available.



Frequency adjustments

Most routes will be adjusted at certain times of the week to match current ridership levels, while also leaving room for ridership to grow. Most Rapid and Frequent routes will continue to operate at least every 15 minutes, and most Connexion and Local routes will operate at least every 30 minutes. Some routes will also be adjusted to reflect lower ridership during the summer months. Check octranspo.com for schedule information.
